It is with great enthusiasm to share with you the development of a charity foundation which I created called Project J.O.Y. – **Join Our Journey**. For over 35 years, my father, Dr. Jesus Ho, spearheaded medical missions yearly to different parts of the Philippines along with my mother, Dr. Priscilla Ho. It was one of his most important legacies. For many years, he asked me to attend one of his missions, but due to kids and work, I was never able to make it. In 2016, before my father passed away, he asked my family to dedicate a medical mission in his honor. In January 2018, my mother, Dr. Priscilla Ho, my sister, Jessica Ho-Scara, my husband, Dr. Joseph Vijungco and myself made his request come to life. Together with the Bisaya Medical Association, the City of Carcar and the Provincial Government of Cebu, we conducted a Medical, Surgical and Dental Mission in Carcar City, Cebu, Philippines treating over 10,000 people and donating over \$15 Million worth of equipment, supplies and medicines.

Now I understand why my father insisted that we do this medical mission. Not only was I touched with the healing hands and hearts of all the missionaries. Not only was I overwhelmed by all the sick that stood in line for days for medical treatment, but it also healed my heart for the loss of my father and inspired me to continue my father's legacy. That is how Project J.O.Y. was born!

MISSION

Our mission is to adopt an underprivileged hospital in the Philippines by providing medical/surgical equipment and collaborate with local medical professionals to help the hospital become a leading medical center that will positively impact the community.

Our goal is to develop the hospital into a major referral hospital where complicated medical and surgical cases can successfully be treated. Over time, by donating millions of dollars of medical/surgical equipment and supplies to the same hospital and educating medical professionals and staff yearly, the hospital will become self-sustainable and will be able to accept more challenging medical cases. This will enable the hospital to provide an array of health care services and medical needs which are not accessible to the community.

I am writing to invite you to be our partner in Project J.O.Y.'s 1st medical/surgical mission. Please join us and help touch thousands of lives as we embark on our mission this coming January 2 -5, 2020. Project J.O.Y. is collaborating with Project C.U.R.E., a Top 20 U.S. Charity Foundation and the largest provider of donated medical supplies and equipment to developing countries around the world. Donated medical/surgical equipment and supplies will be delivered July 1-3, 2019 in a 40-foot container and implemented in the hospital ready for the mission and the missionaries in January 2020.

With the help and support of my family and all of you, I hope we can inspire the next generation of doctors and nurses to volunteer their expertise and time to continue these life changing medical missions. Be the change, be the hero, be the hope that can bring **JOY** back into their lives.
